# Hosts Accredited



An Accredited Event is a recognized competition or tournament by Scholarships 4 Us® that awards Prize Funds funded with Prize Money based on Place Finish through the usage of The Scholarships 4 Us® Program and platforms. Scholarships 4 Us® accredits events and the 'Accredited Hosts' that manage them to provide national standardized competitions and tournaments for Student-Participants. The Scholarships 4 Us® Program's Accredited Events are designed by Accredited Hosts or Scholarships 4 Us®. Once an event has been accredited using the 'Accreditation Criterion' it is uploaded to our website underneath the corresponding category: The Arts, Esports or Sports.

Scholarships 4 Us® defines The Arts as an event in which Place Finish is determined on a subjective basis. Boxing is recognized as an art for the reason that Place Finish is determined by the judges that score each round.

There are three levels of events: local, regional, and national. Every Accredited Event will use the Scholarships 4 Us® General Principles which may include purchasing tickets through the S4Us.portal™ to Upcoming Events. It is up to the discretion of the Accredited Hosts on how to accept their Lineage Fee, but the Expense Fee, Savings Contribution, and Prize Fund will be sent directly to Scholarships 4 Us® through the S4Us.portal™ 'Close An Event Form.'

Every Scholarships 4 Us® will use the [General Principles](#) expressed on [page 4](#) of the [Accredited Events Guide](#).



- i. All events are required to have either 5, 10, 15, 20, or 25 entrants
- ii. A team event must consist of the same number of participants on each team
- iii. The Cost of Entry into an Accredited Event is either \$40, \$80, or \$160
- iv. Every event will use of one the Itemized Allocation Platforms to determine the Prize Fund for Place Finish based on Cost of Entry and Number of Participants
- v. Max participants per team is 25
- vi. Max participants per event is 625
- vii. There shall be no events from July 24<sup>th</sup> - July 31<sup>st</sup> and December 17<sup>th</sup> - January 7<sup>th</sup>
- viii. Events must take at least 2-Hours but no more than 72-Hours to complete and performed in the presence of an Accredited Hosts

Accredited Hosts

- ix. An event must be submitted no less than 1-Week in advance using the 'Create An Event' template in the S4Us.portal™
- x. An Event Cancellation must be submitted 48-Hours prior to the start date
- xi. All events must be closed within 24 hours after the completion of the event using the 'Close An Event' template in the S4Us.portal™
- xii. Both event templates may be uploaded to the corresponding portal

Student-Participants

- xiii. Tickets go on sale 24-Hours prior to the start of an event and close 1-Hour prior
- xiv. Student-Participants must Log-In the S4Us.portal™ and use their Enrollment ID to purchase a ticket
- xv. All ticket sales are FINAL and NON-REFUNDABLE
- xvi. Only 1 ticket purchase is permitted per participant per event
- xvii. Taxation will be paid by the buyer according to national, state, and/or local applicable tax laws
- xviii. Any service fee is passed on to the buyer
- xix. A Student-Participant that is unable to attend the event will only be credited their Savings Contribution (see pg.10)



- ✓ Suitable for Ages 12+
- ✓ Provides creativity and authenticity with a distinct 'original' name
- ✓ Be applicable to function with up to 25 entrants
- ✓ An 'Objective' event must clearly define the measuring tool(s) used to determine each place finish (I.E.- time clock)
- ✓ A 'Subjective' event must clearly define how the 'judges' are chosen and their criteria for 'judging' to determine each Place Finish (I.E.- point scale). A judge must not have any interest in the event or relation to a Student-Participant
- ✓ If applicable, classifications must clearly be defined (I.E.- 17U)
- ✓ If applicable, divisions must clearly be defined (I.E.- Gold/Silver/Bronze)

**COMPETITION FORMAT**

- ◆ THE COMPETITION CONSISTS OF STUDENT-PARTICIPANTS PICKING A THEME FOR A THEATRICAL RE-ENACTMENT
- ◆ ONCE A THEME IS CHOSEN A POOL OF 25 'COMMON' CHARACTERS WILL BE PICKED BY THE STUDENT-PARTICIPANTS THAT REPRESENT THE THEME
- ◆ ALL THE 25 CHARACTERS WILL BE PLACED INTO A UNIT AND EACH STUDENT-PARTICIPANT WILL 'PICK YOUR POISON'
- ◆ STUDENT-PARTICIPANTS ARE REQUIRED TO RE-ENACT A 2-3 MINUTE SCENE, THEATRICALY, FROM THEIR CHARACTER THAT CAPTIVATE THE THEME
- ◆ STUDENT-PARTICIPANTS WILL BE GIVEN A PREDETERMINED TIME PERIOD TO PREPARE

**THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES WILL BE USED TO DETERMINE EACH PLACE**

A 5-PERSON PANEL OF JUDGES WILL CONSIST OF PERSONNEL THAT HAVE NO ASSOCIATION WITH THE STUDENT-PARTICIPANTS AND WILL USE THE FOLLOWING POINT SYSTEM WITH THE TIME MANAGED ON A DISPLAY CLOCK:

**SKILLS CHALLENGE FORMAT**

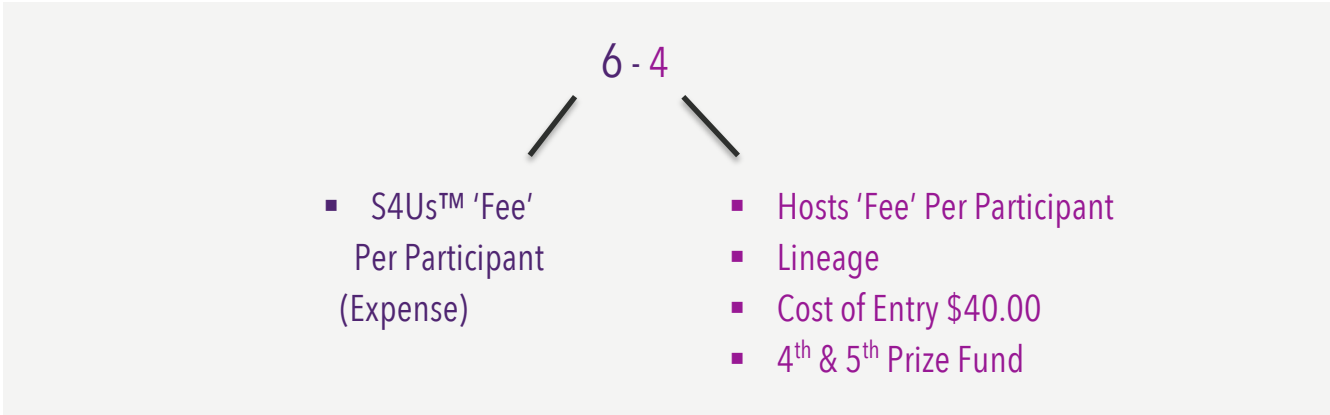
- ◆ THE COMPETITION CONSISTS OF A 3-POINT SKILLS CHALLENGE
- ◆ TIME IS MEASURED USING A SHOT CLOCK

- 1) STUDENT-PARTICIPANTS WILL HAVE 60 SECONDS TO SHOOT 5 BALLS FROM 5 DIFFERENT STATIONS FROM THE 3-POINT LINE
- 2) STUDENT-PARTICIPANTS MAY SHOOT FROM EITHER SIDE OF THE STATION
- 3) FOUR BALLS ON THE RACK WILL BE WORTH 1-POINT AND THE FIFTH COLORED BALL WILL BE WORTH 2-POINTS
- 4) STATION LOCATIONS WILL BE AS FOLLOWED:
  - a) TOP OF THE KEY
  - b) LEFT AND RIGHT WING
  - c) LEFT AND RIGHT BASELINE
- 5) EACH PARTICIPANT WILL RECEIVE 2-QUALIFYING ROUNDS
- 6) POINTS WILL BE A TOTAL OF BOTH ROUNDS COMBINED
- 7) TOP 5 PARTICIPANTS WILL ADVANCE TO THE FINAL ROUND WITH POINTS CARRYING OVER
- 8) IN THE CASE OF A TIE PARTICIPANTS WILL COMPLETE THE SKILLS CHALLENGE AGAIN
- 9) TOTAL COMBINED POINTS FOR ALL 3 ROUNDS WILL DETERMINE PLACE FINISH

3. Each ticket must be purchased individually using the Student-Participants Enrollment ID
4. Only **1-ticket** purchase is allowed **per** participant **per** event
5. Taxation will be **PAID BY THE BUYER** according to national, state, and/or local applicable tax laws
6. Tickets will be emailed and can either be printed out or the QR Code can be scanned at check-in
7. A Student-Participant that is unable to attend the event will **only** be credited their **Savings Contribution**
